Good Morning Cameron,

I see no issue with the roading plans for the main road through the development, even through to Lot's 14-19 where if all bins were presented on the north western side we could reverse down and service these bins.
Our trucks service bins from the left hand side, so we would come in, follow the road to the left, reverse down the driveway to service the bins for 14-19 at the top end, continue round to the carpark and service the bins for 7-9, come out and turn right to get the bins on the inside 4-6 + 27-29 before exiting.

The only issue is when a resident or visitor parks kerbside, I cannot identify from the plans which option of typical road cross section you are implementing here.

We would need a signed indemnity for JJ's from any wear and tare for our truck traversing and turning on all main surfaces, including the main carpark and top driveway for 14-19 if desired.
Our truck has a maximum GVM for NZ roads of 21,000kg.
Overall width 2.49m
Overall length 8.6m
Turning radius kerb to kerb 8.85m
