Further submissions can only be made by persons who are representing a relevant aspect of the public interest or; persons who have an interest in the plan change that is greater than the interest the general public has; or by the local authority that has promulgated the plan change.

The further submission must be in the prescribed Form 6 format and state whether or not you wish to be heard on your submission.
